

AN ACADEMIC MAGNET PROGRAM

We are excited about your interest to pursue an education at Liberty Middle School. The Cambridge Academy is an OCPS Magnet program with a rigorous academic curriculum and multiple opportunities to participate in STEM and the Arts.

The purpose of the Cambridge Academy at Liberty Middle School is to prepare students for the demands and expectations of specialized, advanced academic programs in high school such as Cambridge AICE, IB, and AP.

The curriculum encourages:

- An investigative approach to learning
- The ability to undertake individual projects and to work as part of a team
- Development of writing skills and higher levels of thinking and problem solving

Why Cambridge?

- A Cambridge diploma is a qualification recognized internationally by universities and employers.
- Cambridge students have, on average, a higher university freshman year GPA than those coming from other acceleration programs.
- Studies show that Cambridge programs are equally rigorous as International Baccalaureate programs.
- Students passing Cambridge exams are guaranteed college credit at all Florida public universities.

Why Cambridge in Middle School?

- The opportunity to work as part of a cohort as you progress through Middle School.
- The opportunity to earn up to **8 high school credits** before entering your freshman year.
- A preferred seat in the Cambridge Magnet Program at Colonial High School









RIGOR & FLEXIBILITY

Cambridge students are required to take the advanced core courses, but then have the flexibility to choose the three electives that best fit their interests and future goals. Core classes are taught with an investigative approach to encourage critical thinking and problem solving. All core classroom teachers are gifted endorsed.

GLOBAL PERSPECTIVES

Part of the Cambridge curriculum is broadening students' perspective to a global world. Students in the Cambridge Academy have the opportunity to participate in community nights, service projects, fieldtrips, and earning opportunities that expand the learning outside of the classroom.



- 3.0 GPA or higher (recommended)
- FSA performance equivalent to on-grade level
- Strongly suggested that students participate in the Orange County Virtual 6th grade mathematics course upon acceptance, to prep them for the advanced math content
