ACADEMIC STANDARDS

It is understood that the Cambridge Academy is an advanced program designed for the academically talented. It is an expectation that students maintain a C or better in their core classes. This will ensure that students are understanding the minimum amount of coursework that will be needed to pass the checkpoint tests administered at the end of the school year. Grades will be checked at Progress Reports and Report Cards. Tutoring for academic skills and time management will be offered at check points and at parent request.

CONSEQUENCES OF NOT MEETING ACADEMIC STANDARDS

- The first incident of a D or F on the Report Card will result in a parent conference and the student will be placed on academic probation.
- The second incident a D or F on the Report Card (for the same class) **may** result in dismissal from the Cambridge Program.

The Orange County Code of Student Conduct defines cheating as follows: "Willful or deliberate unauthorized use of the work of another person for academic purposes, or inappropriate use of notes or other material in the completion of an academic assignment or test. In addition to disciplinary responses, the student may receive no credit for the assignment, test, or exam at the discretion of the teacher."

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

Cheating will not be tolerated. The definition of cheating includes, but is not limited to:

- copying another student's work on any independently assigned activity
- allowing another student to complete work for you
- plagiarism

CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ACADEMIC INTEGRITY HONOR CODE

- The first incident of cheating will result in a zero on the assignment and a parent conference.
- The second incident of cheating **may** result in dismissal from the Cambridge Program.

- interacting respectfully with teachers and classmates
- refraining from horseplay
- adherence to the OCPS Student Code of Conduct and Liberty Middle School P.R.I.D.E.

CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH BEHAVIOR HONOR CODE

- The first disciplinary referral will result in a parent conference.
- The second disciplinary referral may result in student being placed on probation.
- The third disciplinary referral may result in dismissal from the Cambridge Program.
